Club members have been busy with work at the range. The three sides of the container shed are finished. The poorly done cement slab has been removed, along with the two containers. The next piece of the project is to pour a new slab inside the entire building. Club member Randy Fischer has plans to build an inside wall where the large container was and we will have a secure storage area there. The other two-thirds of the floor space will be used for a "multi-purpose room - equipment storage, meetings, class room. The front of the building will be finished with an overhead door, and a man door.

Upcoming projects: complete the meeting building, will need to get the annual mowing done soon, and will need a tractor with sprayer for weed control on the firebreak.
