Starting January 1st Club dues will increase. We have developed a terrific facility and we have not had a dues increase in nearly 20 years.

Dues will double: Annual - \$80, Family - \$120, Full Life - \$1000, Senior/Disabled Life - \$500.

Also, we will be capping the total membership at 1000, with 250 Life and 750 Annual. Once the cap is reached membership will be on a first come-first served basis. People on the Life waiting list must maintain a current annual club membership.
