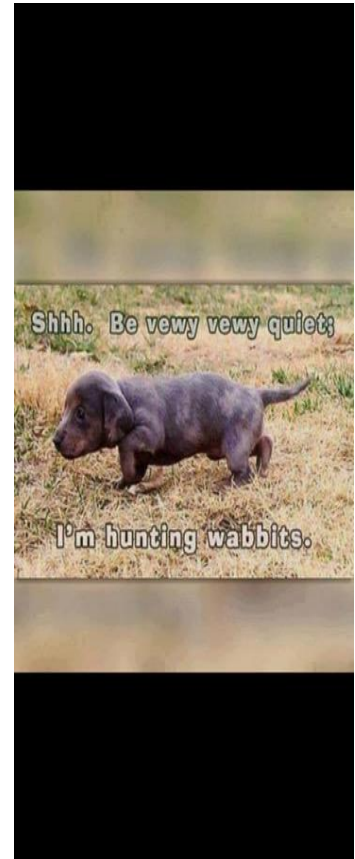


Range Fire Sat. Sept. 15th
